1. Development (D)

1.1 Education

The following initiatives will be undertaken

- 1) Support and monitor the implementation of NRM Manifesto on Education
- 2) Set up a sustainable education support fund (ESF) for venerable students
- 3) Disability support Centre to support people with disabilities
- 4) Skilling Centre to support the skilling of the youth and women
- 5) Set up Ibanda teachers appreciation day to recognize and thank them for their contribution to Ibanda District
- 6) Lobby Government and other partners to support students with sanitary amenities
- 7) Promote education policies that focus on education governance and financing, human resource management, teaching, primary and secondary school management and supervision, technical/ Vocational and university education.
- 8) Promote continuous professional development/training of teachers and eLearning in schools.
- 9) Facilitate the provision of revision materials for PLE, UCE and UACE candidates of Ibanda District

1.2 Health Care

Quality Health for All

The focus will be on:

- 1) Support and monitor the implementation of the NRM manifesto on Health Sector
- 2) Continue to lobby and network with Government Institutions and Development partners to support the health sector in Ibanda District
- 3) Promote primary health care, awareness campaigns, against non-communicable diseases and HIV/AIDS prevention testing and treatment
- 4) Mobilize resources and install a cervical cancer screening machine for women and lobby for other medical tools and equipment
- 5) Oversee and ensure the stocking of essential drugs in Government Hospitals
- 6)** Dissemination of information on Sexual and Reproductive Health for adolescents and young people.
- 7)** Equal opportunities for all in testing and treatment

1.3 The Agriculture

The focus will be on:

- 1) Promotion and monitoring the implementation of NRM Manifesto on Agriculture sector
- 2) Training of farmers in new and modern methods of farming such as irrigation, mechanization, use of fertilizers and water harvest
- 3) Distribution of improved variety seed to farmers
- 4) Promote the creation storage facilities and other post-harvest handling facilities
- 5) Promoting commercial farming in Ibanda District
- 6) Promote Agricultural insurance for commercial farming
- 7) Promote Production for export
- 8) Promote the starting of an agro-industrial park in Ibanda
- 9) Promote the one-acre model to maximize land usage

Lobby for boreholes, protected well springs and access to piped water in Ibanda District

Promote tree planting in Ibanda district

Lobby Rural electricity Agency and the government to connect power and construct more roads respectively in all sub counties in Ibanda District.

Support the construction of Permanent Houses for selected households especially for the widows and other vulnerable people
